

In the Kitchen



WHIPPED SHORTBREAD COOKIES

Ingredients:

- 1 cup unsalted butter—softened
- ¾ cup powdered sugar (plus additional for imprinting cookies)
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- ¾ teaspoon table salt
- 2 cups all purpose flour
- 2 tablespoons cornstarch

Optional: cherries, sprinkles, icing



- 1. Preheat oven to 325F (165C) and line a baking sheet with parchment paper. Set aside.
- 2. Combine butter & powdered sugar in a large mixing bowl and use an electric hand mixer and beat on medium-highspeed until lightened in colour, fluffy, and creamy (about 5 minutes)
- 3. Add vanilla extract and salt. Stir until combined.
- 4. In a separate bowl, whisk together flour and cornstarch.
- 5. Turn mixer speed to medium-low and gradually add flour, stirring until just combined.
- 6. Scoop dough into tablespoon sized scoops and briefly roll between your palms to make smooth balls. Place on cooking sheet, spacing about 1-2 inches apart.
- 7. Use a fork to gently, slightly flatten each cookie.
- 8. Sprinkle cookies or add cherries or icing (optional)
- 9. Put in oven at 325 and bake for about 12 minutes. Cookies will still be light in colour when finished baking. Allow to cool completely on baking sheet before removing.
